

A Curriculum Vitae or rather Curriculum Vitae <u>Postea</u> - the <u>Future</u> Course of Life - for Couples.

The Couple Profile

• Describe yourself as a couple in a succinct blurb. This will require some talking and drafting, to write a good enough blurb about you two. e.g. "We are a rockstar duo that plays at night!"

Couple's Skills

• List your couple joint skills - incl. those that only surface when you are a team at its best.

Couple's Love Languages

• The concept of the 5 Love Languages says that each of us have a preferred way of expressing affection. It can be physical touch, material gifts, or offering quality time. List the sum of your two love expressing languages. Add your own terminology, if needed.

Couple's Zone of Next Development

• Kids thrive when they see older or more advanced kids than themselves in the Zone of Next Development. Describe what is an inspiring zone that you as a couple seek to imitate and learn from. e.g. "We formulated pillars for our wedding, but want to improve future planning."

Values

 Navigating complex social situations is easier when you are clear on what is important to you. Find 5 values just like your fingers on a hand. Values are fairly stable yet can change across periods of time and depending on culture. e.g. "Authenticity, Freedom, Connectedness, Self Realization, Frugality."

Triggers

• Triggers are topics that irk us yet that we are weirdly attracted to. We bring up such trigger topics on the way home from a party as in "Did you see what she did?" It's ok. Nothing goes away until it taught us some thing. Just list them. e.g. "Pinchiness & To-Much-Info Sharing"

Portfolio

 Shine with your pride projects. What have you accomplished together? Who took what role, how was that negotiated? What skills were used? what insights gained. Talk a lot. Then boil it down to 4 bullets. e.g. "Project Founding a company, Amsterdam, NL 2009" or "Raising Kids" or "A memorable party at the Beach"

Fails

 Add your stand-alone fail projects - times when you fucked up together. Like a bad tattoo on your skin. Talk a lot. A project title is then enough. e.g. "Bought Overpriced Car", "Abortion", "No savings for Corona"
